## Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 23, 1984 (1CNA048402), the NRC requested that AP&L consider an alternate approach to resolving the Natural Circulation Cooldown issue as requested by Generic Letter 81-21. Specifically, an approach used by GPU was mentioned as an acceptable methodology for resolving the NRC concerns. The letter requested AP&L to provide a schedule for responding within 30 days.

AP&L has witnessed a brief presentation of the GPU methodology and we are willing to investigate further the possibility of a similar approach by AF&L. We will be working with the B&W Owners Group on this issue and expect that our formal response to your request for re-evaluation of the issue will be submitted by September 1, 1984.
