APPENDIX A

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Philadelphia Electric Company Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1 Docket No. 50-352 License No. CPPR-106

As a result of the inspection conducted on April 1-30, 1984, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register Notice (49 FR 8583) dated March 8, 1984, the following violations were identified:

A. 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion III requires the establishment of measures to assure that applicable design basis for systems and components are correctly translated into drawings.

Section 3 of Volume 1 of the Limerick Generating Station Quality Assurance Plan implements these requirements of Criterion III.

Contrary to the above, as of April 24, 1984, the measures established to incorporate implemented design changes into applicable drawings failed to assure that all changes made to the high pressure coolant injection system by Design Change Package 232 were reflected in Piping and Instrumentation Diagram M42.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement II).

B. 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion V requires that activities affecting quality shall be prescribed by appropriate procedures and these procedures shall be followed during performance of these activities.

Startup Administrative Procedure AD 1.2-2 and Appendix Z to Volume 1 of the Limerick Generating Station Quality Assurance (QA) Plan require that Startup Nonconformance Reports be reviewed by the licensee's Quality Control and Quality Assurance organizations to determine if conditions exist which require reporting to the NRC per 10 CFR 50.55e.

Contrary to the above, AD 1.2-2 and Appendix Z to the QA Plan were not effectively followed in that the review provided for Startup Nonconformance Reports S-346-M, S-347-M, and S-414-M, involving failures of electrohydraulic operators for ventilation system dampers, failed to identify that these failures constituted a condition which warranted reporting.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement II).

C. 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion V requires that activities affecting quality shall be prescribed by appropriate procedures.

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147/WIGGINS/5/17/84 - 0001.0.0 05/17/84 Section 16 of the Startup Activity Section of the Limerick Generating Station Quality Assurance Plan requires that measures shall be established to assure conditions adverse to quality are promptly identified, reported and corrected.

Contrary to the above, the measures necessary to promptly identify, report and correct those conditions adverse to quality which were associated with facility buildings, areas and rooms were not prescribed by appropriate Startup Administrative procedures as required by the Limerick Quality Assurance Plan.

This is a Severicy Level V Violation (Supplement II).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, Philadelphia Electric Company is hereby required to submit to this office, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written reply including: (1) corrective steps taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending your response time.
