Thank you for your letter of January 5, 1984, in response to our letter and the attached Notice of Violation and Notice of Deviation, dated December 5, 1983. As a result of our review, we find that additional information, as discussed with your Mr. Wisenberg during a telephone call on May 30, 1984, is needed. Specifically, we would like you to provide information on the current status of your program to reconcile records and training documentation related to the Anchor Bolt/Embed Evaluation Program and on the status of testing of safety-related anchor bolts. Since this issue is somewhat complex, your response should show the relationship of your actions to your relevant commitments such that the response stands alone. Please provide the supplemental information within 30 days of the date of this letter.
