MOSBAUGH: That's correct. 16 17 ODOM: They're saying --MOSBAUGH: That's in the log somewhere. 18 19 ODOM: They're saying ... They don't recall ever hearing that before. 20 21 MOSBAUGH: Uh-huh. And the start phrase --BEACHER: "Eighteen starts with no 6 problem" -- he said that he had heard that before, 7 and he thinks that's not true. 8 ODOM: Brockman spoke up and said --9 BEACHER: Brockman spoke up -- spoke up 10 11 and made a comment that --ODOM: "You heard it from us." 12 BEACHER: Yeah, "you heard it from us." 13 ODOM: Region II and (inaudible.) 14 BEACHER: He said he was going to check 15 into it. 16 ODOM: Li's say then they said -- then 17 Brockman -- then Chaffee said, "Well, I know 18 19 something's not right about that." And he said, "We're going to check into that." (Inaudible.) 20 What I'm trying to say is that that was in the LER. 21 22 MOSBAUGH: Yean. Well, one of the different ways, whether it's in the response to the 23 confirmation of action letter --24 25 ODOM: Right, the April 5th.

1 MOSBAUGH: -- or George's presentation in the Region. 2 3 BEACHER: Yeah, Lewis Ward. . . MOSBAUGH: I brought it up with them, and 4 I told Shipman; and I said, you know, "This is not 5 6 true." 7 ODOM: Yeah. MOSBAUGH: "You guys better check your 8 9 facts." And I gave him specific data on dates and times that -- where I was aware that we had known 10 11 failures. ODOM: Oh, yeah. This is ... I wish that 12 day we had a real sensitive issue with the thing ... 13 (Inaudible.) 14 MOSBAUGH: They blew it off. 15 ODOM: I thought they did, too, that's 16 17 what I heard. I heard the Region was contacted and 18 said, "Okay, we understand." 19 MOSBAUGH: I was on the phone with the 20 whole thing. They blew it off. 21 ODOM: And they might blow it off now, but this IIT team ---22 23 MOSBAUGH: No. What I mean is they -- I 24 mean SONOPCO blew it off. 25 ODOM: Oh, okay.

1	MOSBAUGH: I'm not saying the NRC blew it
2	off.
3	ODOM: I heard that we contacted Brockman
4	personally
5	MOSBAUGH: McCoy came back on the
6	conversation on the phone and said, "Yeah, I just
7	talked to Ken Brockman, and he understands that
8	there were failures in the process of coming out of
9	the maintenance on the machine." Okay. Well, that
10	may be, okay. There were failures coming out of
11	the maintenance on the machine, okay, but there were
12	also failures in a period of time that I considered
13	to be beyond the maintenance on the machine.
14	ODOM: Okay.
15	MOSBAUGH: Okay?
16	BEACHER: They want to talk with the guy
17	who actually did the work on those valves, the
18	accumulator installation valve, the charging and
19	pump valve. They want to talk with Mike Kagel again
20	concerning installation of the hatch, pressurizing
21	manway. I guess what they're getting at getting
22	at is how the communication related. It appears as
23	though Hopkins told Mike Kagle (inaudible).

MOSBAUGH: [Reading] Lube oil pressure sensor 1 2 malfunction and fuel oil level high. 3 (Inaudible.) ODOM: They're saying this right here is new 4 to them (inaudible). 5 VOICE: They never heard that piece of 6 7 information. Although they've got the narrative the 8 9 same as we do. MOSBAUGH: (Inaudible.) tripped the 10 diesel. 11 ODOM: It's in the narrative though. 12 13 WEBB: That's where it came from. It 14 came from the Event report. ODOM: The other problem that they had a 15 problem with was the starts. 16 WEBB: Where did we talk about that? 17 18 VOICE: I don't know. (Inaudible.) WEBB: Oh, it's the number of starts 19 (inaudible). 20 MOSBAUGH: Where it's at, Tom? 21 22 WEBB: Back towards the end, wasn't it? BEACHER: Was it page 6 or something? 23 (Telephone ringing.) 24 25 MOSBAUGH: On page 6, halfway.

1 (Inaudible.) 2 VOICE: [Reading] "Have been started 3 at least eighteen times each and no failure or problems have occurred during any of these starts." 4 5 ODOM: That's true. Any of the eighteen times ---6 7 VOICE: I know it's true the way it's written. But it's very misleading. 8 ODOM: I told Al they were hitting on 9 that. They were really focused on that. 10 WEBB: I thought Brockman was going to 11 12 explain it to them. 13 ODOM: I thought he was going to help us 14 out. He didn't ---15 WEBB: 16 ODOM: He said, "What you heard where the 17 problem was is from the Region." And he dropped it, right there. And that's all he said. You know, 18 19 like, come on, Ken, speak up. Tell us some more --20 VOICE: Another guestion --21 ODOM: -- if you know more, help us out 22 here (chuckling). 23 VOICE: I thought we explained that to them. 24 ODOM: Yeah, McCoy talked to him; that's 25 what I heard.

WEBB: And these fellows observed that 1 the jacket water pressure was 12 to 13 pounds. They 2 3 asked if that was when the diesel was running or after a trip. I said, "Well, the way it reads, I 4 think it's after the trip." (Inaudible.) He said, 5 "Okay." 6 ODOM: That's the way he understood it, too. VOICE: SO 7 he understands. ODOM: Okay. You wanted to be informed 8 of that; obviously two or three ears were on that 9 phone call today? 10 MOSBAUGH: Uh-huh. 11 ODOM: And uh, I wish these guys would 12 just go away, man. 13 MOSBAUGH: Uh-huh. 14 15 BEACHER: (Inaudible) come back with three sets of data taken, which we told them ---16 ODOM: Yes, it was ---17 18 BEACHER: -- yes, it was taken. However, now they want to see the dog-gone data. 19 20 ODOM: But they're the same. BEACHER: I know. They -- they were the 21 22 same, the actual. ODOM: We can get it to them. It's the same 23
