Dear Senator Graham:

I am responding to your letter of December 2, 1991, which enclosed an October 30, 1991, letter from one of your constituents, Mr. Regino R. Diaz-Robainas, that provided an allegation concerning Florida Power and Light Company's (FPL) management of the operation and engineering support at Turkey Point.

We had previously received the specifics of Mr. Diaz-Robainas' allegation and had organized a plan to address his concerns. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted a team inspection at FPL corporate offices and the Turkey Point Site. Preliminary results indicate no immediate safety concerns. The portion of the allegation concerning an NRC employee has been forwarded to the NRC Inspector General. The inspection report will be finalized early in 1992 and will be provided to your office and to Mr. Diaz-Robainas.

Additionally, we met with FPL on November 18, 1991, and Mr. Diaz-Robainas on November 21, 1991, to discuss the preliminary, predecisional findings of the team inspection, and to afford Mr. Diaz-Robainas an opportunity to provide additional information. Mr. Diaz-Robainas was not able to provide us with additional substantive information.

I trust that issuance of the Team Inspection Report will satisfy your request.
