SUBJECT: LICENSEE QUALIFICATION MEETING SUMMARY

On April 24 and 25, 1984, the NRC staff met with Duquesne Light Company at the Johnson Street School in Aliquippa, Pennsylvania. The meeting attendees were as follows: Gary Beatty (DLC/lead engineer), Tom Burns, (DLC/Acting Director of Training), Marilyn Ley (NRC/DL) and David Shum (NRC/LQB). The purpose of the meeting was to identify the training information necessary for docketing. The information previously submitted by DLC did not reflect the quality of the DLC training program, nor did it provide a sufficient basis for the NRC review.

Section 13.2 of the BVPS-2 draft Safety Evaluation Report (SER) identified twelve items of concern. These twelve items were discussed in detail at the meeting, and are presented in Enclosure 1. Following discussions, DLC and NRC agreed on the information necessary to resolve the items. Item #3 requires no further action from DLC. Further actions will be taken by the NRC to determine if Item #4 will constitute an open item in the SER. With regard to the remaining ten items, the applicant has agreed to submit the necessary information. Resolution to items #1, #2, and #9 requires the submittal of actual excerpts from the DLC Training Program: Introduction to the DLC BVPS-2 Thermodynamics Lesson Plan, Westinghouse Reactor Operator Start-up Certification course description, and the Introduction to the DLC BVPS-2 Transient and Accident Analysis/Mitigating Core Damage Lesson Plan. Item #2 also requires a mutually agreed upon revision to the FSAR.

DLC stated that the training information would be submitted to the NRC in time to meet the July 2, 1984 SER deadline.
