Dear Mr. Youngblood:

In our April 5, 1984 letter, (PY-CEI/NRR-0104 L), we requested that the on-site audits by the Seismic Qualification Review Team (SQRT) and the Pump and Valve Operability Review Team (PVORT) be scheduled for the week of August 13, 1984. To support that audit date, the following information is being provided to the NRC Equipment Qualification Branch reviewer.

- 2) Master equipment lists sorted by equipment number and procurement specification.
- (4) Equipment qualification report status and schedule lists for the NSSS and balance of plant equipment specifications, for both operability and seismic qualification.

As previously committed, the equipment installation status as of May 18, 1984 is shown on the master equipment lists. Those items highlighted reflect the equipment which meets the installation acceptance criteria except for status of specific hangers for associated equipment. Pipe hanger installation is reported on a bulk basis and is presently 85% complete.


