SUBJECT:

POSSIBLE ENFORCEMENT ACTION REGARDING GRAND GULF

My previous memorandum of April 19, 1984, to you identified some FSAR discrepancies resulting from licensee's comparison of the FSAR with the asbuilt plant.

In its final report on the Technical Specification Review Program transmitted by letter dated April 19, 1984 to Harold Denton, with cc to you, the licensee has identified many FSAR (application) inconsistencies (Attachment H to the April 19 letter). Licensee's comments on the safety significance of these inconsistencies are also provided in its April 19, 1984 final report (Attachment F).

The licensee plans to amend the FSAR this month to eliminate these inconsistencies. However, I wanted to advise you of these identified inconsistencies, as you may wish to follow up on the need for possible enforcement action.
