AND REPLIES TO THE PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION ON
CHEATING

Discussion: Comments and reply submissions have been received from the parties on whether the Licensing Board's Partial Initial Decision (PID) on the cheating incidents should be made immediately effective. Both the NRC staff and licensee recommend revoking the immediate effectiveness of the Commission's shutdown order. The other parties, including the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, oppose such a decision by the Commission. A summary of their positions and an analysis of potential effects on your immediate effectiveness review follow.
