This letter provides Gulf States Utilities Company's (GSU) response to Generic Letter 91-11 "Resolution of Generic Issue 48; LCOs for Class 1E Vital Instrument Buses, and Generic Issue 49; Interlocks and LCOs for Class 1E Tie Breakers". Actions requested by this generic letter include assurance that licensees have appropriate procedures to fulfill the following requirements.

1. Limit the time that a plant is in possible violation of the single failure criterion with regard to the Class 1E vital instrument buses.
2. Require surveillances of these components.
3. Ensure that, except for the times covered in Item (1), the plant is operating in an electrical configuration consistent with the regulations and its design basis.

River Bend Station (RBS) is a General Electric (GE) BWR 6. RBS technical specifications are based on GE standard technical specifications and therefore contain the appropriate LCOs to satisfy the single failure criterion. To assure independence between redundant buses, there are no tie breakers between redundant safety-related buses at River Bend. Procedural and administrative controls are used to provide assurance that no temporary cross connections between safety-related buses are made in violation of technical specification requirements.

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
