Subject: MEDIA INTEREST IN DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS TAKEN AGAINST OPERATORS

There has been local media interest today in disciplinary actions taken yesterday by Florida Power Corporation against six Crystal River 3 licensed operators. The six were involved in an unauthorized test in September 1994, involving the makeup tank overpressure. The discipline for each of the six ranged from verbal counselling to termination.

The State of Florida was informed.

The NRC headquarters duty officer received official notification from the licensee of this disciplinary action at 4:13 p.m. on August 23, 1995.

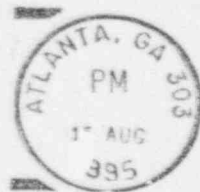
