Enc. of ure 1 is a list of attendees.

The meeting was conducted as an exchange of information only and no licensing commitments were made. Peach Bottom issues discussed included upcoming plans to incorporate a twenty-four month fuel cycle into the technical specifications, plans to seek an increase in the facility's licensed rated power and PECo activities concerning Improved Standard Technical Specifications. Limerick issues discussed included technical specification manges required to support repair of some emergency service water piping, anges to snubber functional testing and disposition of nozzle to safe end and indication on the Unit 1 NoH nozzle.


