This condition existed for about 4 1/2 hours due to the air binding of the pump used to add the dechlorinating agent. The pump was vented and returned to service. Due to the infrequency and upredictability of this event, no further corrective action is deemed necessary. The matter had been communicated to you by telephone on June 21, 1983.
