



To be conservative, you might also assume that the hearing will be consolidated with that part of the Midland OL safety hearing on the soil settlement issue, and thus intervenor Marshall and Sinclair and the State of Michigan will also participate. On this basis, the discovery period and hearing will be fairly active, with significant support required of Corps of Engr. and ETEC.

At the moment our consultants are trying to come up to speed and to provide us their inputs at our scheduled meeting with them on January 15 in preparation for our meeting with Consumer Power the following day.

Emphasis is on identifying what criteria we need for the corrective actions.
