Gentlemen:

Entergy Operations has recently implemented a design change package that requires a revision to the Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO) Industr_al Security Plan (ISP). A brief description of the change is included as Attachment 1. This change will be incorporated in a forthcoming revision of the ISP. This change has been discussed with members of the Staff at NRR and Region IV.

In accordance with 10CFR50.54(p), it was determined by Entergy Operations that this change does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan and, therefore, may be implemented without prior NRC approval.

The attached material describes current and proposed security measures; therefore, Entergy Operations has determined that the attached documentation contains safeguards information as specified by 10CFR73.21. The attached documentation should therefore be handled appropriately.
