Thank you for your letter dated January 10, 1992, in response to our November 26, 1°91 letter concerning apparent aberrant behavior by an employee at provide wood Station (AMS RIII-91-A-0100).

In our letter we requested that you describe the incident on November 18, 1991 and any action you may have taken to address it and inform us if the incident was handled in accordance with your Fitness-For-Duty program. Additionally, we requested that you assure that the employee is fit-for-duty and verify that he does not pose a threat to your facility.

Your response indicated that the incident actually occurred on November 14, 1991 and that the results of your investigation failed to support the concerns pertaining to the employee. Your Medical Review Officer's evaluation determined that the subject employee showed no signs of psychological or psychiatric abnormalities, posed no threat to your facilities and there was no Fitness For-Duty concerns.

We found your investigation to be sufficient to support your conclusions and have no additional questions regarding this matter. We request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation of these concerns for a minimum of one year from the date of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
