SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-327/91-28 AND 50-328/91-28

This refers to the inspection conducted by E. D. Testa of this office on November 18-22, 1991. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Sequoyah facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified; however, we remain concerned about your continued high person-rem collective dose as demonstrated by the high collective doses received for the shot peening work in the recent Unit 1 outage. We will be reviewing your application of lessons learned from this experience during future outages.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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
