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Dear Mr. Jones:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 78 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-40 for the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit No. 1. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated November 18, 1983.

The amendment incorporates administrative changes which achieve agreement between the Fort Calhoun Station Technical Specifications and new regulations which became effective on January 1, 1984. Specifically, section 10 CFR 50.54(m)(2) and (m)(3) became effective and paragraph (m) of 10 CFR 50.54 was redesignated paragraph (m)(1) on January 1, 1984. These paragraphs address licensed operator staffing at nuclear power units. This rule change affects the current technical specifications in the area of shift manning.

The amendment also changes to whom the Quality Control (QC) personnel report. The change permits the QC personnel to report to the Technical Supervisor. Our evaluation of your proposed Technical Specifications dealing with NRC notification and reporting is continuing. This will be the subject of a separate licensing action.

A copy of the Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next regular monthly Federal Register notice.

The amendment incorporates administrative changes which achieve agreement between the Fort Calhoun Station Technical Specifications and new regulations which became effective on January 1, 1984. Specifically, section 10 CFR 50.73 entitled "Licensee Event Report System" became effective on January 1, 1984. This rule change affects the current technical specifications in the area of reporting requirements. In addition, section 10 CFR 50.54(m)(2) and (m)(3) became effective and paragraph (m) of 10 CFR 50.54 was redesignated paragraph (m)(1) on January 1, 1984. These paragraphs address licensed operator staffing at nuclear power units. This rule change affects the current technical specifications in the area of shift manning. Lastly section 10 CFR 50.72 entitled "Immediate Notification Requirements for Operating Nuclear Power Reactors" was revised and became effective on January 1, 1984. This rule change also affects the current technical specifications in the area of reporting requirements.

The amendment also changes to whom the Quality Control (QC) personnel report. The change permits the QC personnel to report to the Technical Supervisor.

A copy of the Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next regular monthly Federal Register notice.
