

Gentlemen:

This is in reply to L. M. Mills letter of May 1, 1984, which informed us of TVA's intentions for temporary use of interim low-level radioactive waste storage facilities at Browns Ferry and Sequoyah Nuclear Power Plants.

The requirement for a quarterly sampling program of two control resin liners was intended to ensure long-term container integrity throughout the five-year interim storage period of the license. Clearly, TVA's interpretation of the license, to temporarily store (less than two months) resin liners without initiating a control liner monitoring program, is valid and consistent with the intent of the license.
