During a May 8, 1984, discussion with Mr. Tom Novak, Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) was requested to have General Electric Corporation perform an overview review of the MP&L Technical Specification Review Program. This letter documents the completion and results of General Electric's overview review.

The overview review, utilizing General Electric's BWR design and operating experience, involved the review of those portions of the Technical Specifications and supporting documentation which were not reviewed by them during the Technical Specification Review Program. In support of this overview review effort, General Electric reviewed Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Balance of Plant and MP&L portions of the Technical Specifications. General Electric characterized their findings as enhancements or, in some cases, improvements in wording.

MP&L believes that the successful completion of General Electric's overview review of the Technical Specification Review Program provides additional assurance that the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications are complete and adequate.
