Re: Peach Bottom Atomic Station, Units 2 and 3

By letter of June 3, 1983, the NRC requested Philadelphia Electric Company to comply with the requirements of NUREG-0737. Item JI.K.3.18 by choosing between two alternative modifications that the staff found acceptable.

As a result, Philadelphia Electric Company submitted a letter dated July 15, 1983, that commits the utility to modifying the ADS logic by eliminating the high drywell pressure permissive and adding a manual inhibit switch. This modification was found acceptable by the staff in its Safety Evaluation enclosed in its letter of June 3, 1983.

Based on your July 15, 1983 commitment, we consider this issue to be closed.
