Subject: Task Order No. 12, Entitled, "Technical Assistance in the Review of Brunswick Steam Electric Plant ISFS" Under Contract No. NRC-02-90-009

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Task Order No. 12. This effort shall be performed in accordance with the enclosed Statement of Work, the Contractor's proposal dated November 21, 1991, and the following telephonic changes of December 5, 1991:

Decrease indirect overhead rate from 87.10% to 86.60%.
Decrease G&A rate from 10.30% to 10%.
Decrease fixed fee from 10% to 1%.
Adjust proposed costs in accordance with the above changes.

Task Order No. 12 shall be in effect from December 24, 1991 through February 19, 1992, with a cost ceiling of \$18,650.00 of which \$18,464.00 represents the estimated reimbursable costs and \$186.00 represents the fixed fee. Of this amount \$14,161.00 is obligated at this time. This amount should not be exceeded until notice is provided to you that additional funds are available. It is estimated that this obligated amount will cover performance of work through February 5, 1992.




