ORDER

By letter dated March 30, 1984 from Joseph Gallo, Esq., one of the Applicant's attorneys, the Board was informed that the parties were meeting to consider the means for resuming the hearing process. A method was established for the revision or amendment of certain contentions and replies thereto, leading to a scheduling meeting to be held on or about May 24. There was also to be an effort to reconcile differences regarding Contention 8 (siting criteria) of the Neiner Farm group, and Contention 4 (explosives) was ready for ruling by the Board. Subsequently the Board was requested to withhold temporarily rulings on these contentions.

All parties are hereby requested to submit updated information to the Board regarding the status of all contentions, including proposed

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revisions or amendments. This includes representatives of the Neiner Farm group if they wish to continue as intervenors in this proceeding. The parties should also submit their recommendations regarding a proposed schedule, while continuing with informal discovery on a cooperative basis. All filings shall be in the hands of the Board not later than 30 days from the date of this Order.
