(OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission met to discuss the Grand Gulf plant currently operating under NRC license condition that restricts operation to low power levels.

The Commission, by a vote of 3-2 (Commissioners Gilinsky and Asselstine dissenting), voted to oppose Commissioner Gilinsky's proposal that NRC not allow the plant to operate until the Commission has acted on an exemption request.

The Commission, by a vote of 3-2 (Commissioners Gilinsky and Asselstine dissenting), voted to oppose Commissioner Asselstine's motion that the Commission rescind the portion of the staff's order that modifies the technical specifications for the plant, the limiting condition for operation.

The Commission directed the staff to proceed as it is and to consider the exemption request when it arrives. (EDO) (SECY Suspense: 6/18/84)
