SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PUBLICATION IN MONTHLY FR NOTICE - NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE AND PROPOSED NO SIGNIFICA \* HAZARDS CONSIDERATION DETERMINATION AND OPPORTUNITY OR A HEARING

Public Service Co. of Colorado, Docket No. 50-267, Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Generating Station, Platteville, Colorado

Date of amendment request: May 10, 1984

Description of amendment request: The proposed change to the Technical Specifications would modify the secondary coolant activity analysis requirements. The change would: 1) eliminate the need for daily sampling if the activity increases by 25% over an equilibrium value, and 2) require daily sampling and analysis if the activity increases to 10 percent instead of the existing 25 percent of the Limiting Condition for Operation limit and weekly sampling at all other times during reactor operation.

Basis for proposed no significant hazards consideration determination: The Commission has provided guidance concerning the application of these standards by providing certain examples (48 FR 14870). The examples of actions that are considered not likely to involve significant hazards considerations include changes that constitute an additional limitation, restriction, or control not presently included in the Technical Specifications: for example, a more stringent surveillance requirement.
