Revision to Requested Amendment to NPF-82 to Permit Implementation of Shoreham Decommissioning Plan Shoreham Nuclear Power Station - Unit 1 Docket No. 50-322

## Gentlemen:

The Long Island Power Authority (LIPA) has proposed an amendment (reference 1) to the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station Possession Only License, NPF-82 requesting that the NRC authorize LIPA to implement the Shoreham Decommissioning Plan. On Wednesday, January 2., 1992, LIPA revised the no significant hazards consideration analysis which appears in attachment 1 of the reference (1) letter to facilitate NRC review and approval. This revision appears in the reference (2) letter. This request would take effect only after the NRC has consented to the pending joint request of Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) and LIPA to transfer NPF-82 from LILCO to L PA.

In connection with the above, L. LCO urges that:

- (1) the NRC Staff expeditiously review the request;
- (2) the NRC review the requested amendment in the Shoreham docket, No. 50-322; and
