The Commission has issued the enclosed exemption from the requirements of Section III.J of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix R in response to your letter dated June 29, 1995. The exemption, which is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication, pertains to certain requirements for emergency lighting in specified areas of the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station.

In your letter, you also requested to withdraw an exemption from the requirements of Section III.J of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix R, for certain areas of the Reactor Building. The exemption was granted on June 26, 1999, and you stated that it is no longer required because conforming emergency lighting had been installed in the affected areas. Therefore, the Commission has revoked the exemption. The enclosed Revocation of Exemption is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
