We find the changes in the subject letter and the attachments thereto to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) with the following exceptions:

- Security officers must be trained regarding incapacitating chemicals before they are issued.
- The training must be described in the Training and Qualification Plan as a specific task which security officers will be required to maintain requalification proficiency.

The above matters were discussed during a phone conversation between Mr. Hamm of your staff and Mr. Dexter of this office on January 14, 1992. It is our understanding that these items will be included in your next plan revision. Your other changes are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.
