Gentlemen:

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated November 22, 1991, by which you transmitted Revision 27 to the Cooper Nuclear Station Safeguards Plan for your facility.

We find the changes in the subject letter and the attachments thereto to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) with the following exceptions:

- ° Security officers must be trained regarding incapacitating chemicals before they are issued.
- ° The training must be described in the Training and Qualification Plan as a specific task which security officers will be required to maintain requalification proficiency.

The above matters were discussed during a phone conversation between Mr. Hamm of your staff and Mr. Dexter of this office on January 14, 1992. It is our understanding that these items will be included in your next plan revision. Your other changes are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguard Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.


Nebraska Public Power District is submitting, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 50.54(p), a Report of Change - Revision 27 to the Cooper Nuclear Station Safeguards Plan.

These changes reflect the modified shotgun qualification course now prevalent in the industry and changes the equipment available for a security officer's unarmed defense posture from the PC-24 baton to the more practical and effective pepper mace.

The District has concluded that the enclosed change does not decrease the effectiveness of the security plan.

The material enclosed herewith contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR Part 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited. Therefore, we request the material to be withheld from public disclosure.
