Dear Mr. Fitzpatrick:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by J. A. Isom, D. G. Passehl, J. F. Harold, C. N. Orsini, T. G. Colburn, B. Hollan, E. R. Schweibinz, and J. R. Roton of this office from November 27, 1991, through January 14, 1992, of activities at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-58 and DPR-74, and to the discussion of our findings with A. A. Blind and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. The activities involved failure to perform safety evaluations to ensure that no unreviewed safety question would result from modifications made to the facility.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 or the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosures, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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
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
