This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. G. Napuda of this office on April 30 - May 4, 1984, at the Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1 in Limerick and at your Philadelphia, Pennsylvania corporate offices of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-106; activities relating to your application for an NRC operating license; and, to Mr. Napuda's discussions of our findings with Messrs. C. Leitch, R. Moore and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the NRC Region I Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

This inspection was performed as part of the NRC routine inspection program to determine the status of your Quality Assurance Program prior to operation of the Limerick Station, Unit 1. Based on this inspection, we found two items that must be satisfactorily corrected by PECo before operating license (OL) issuance. Another item requires action prior to commercial operation. These items and the committments made by your management representatives are identified in the attached report (paragraphs 4.5, 7.4 and 9.4).

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1). The telephone notification of your intent to request withholding, or any request for an extension of the 10-day period which you believe necessary, should be made to the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, USNRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223.

No reply to this letter is required. However, should a misunderstanding exist between us please provide a letter to us within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter clarifying your intent.

Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.
