POTENTIAL EXPORT OF SIMULATOR TO THE PEOPLES REPUBLIC

OF CHINA

Enclosed for appropriate action by your Office is a letter from the Carolina Power and Light Company that discusses its intentions to negotiate the sale of a used control room simulator for a nuclear power plant to Sci-Tech, Inc. The letter indicates that Sci-Tech, Inc. in turn, will probably seek to export the simulator to the Peoples Republic of China.

This matter was brought to my attention by Mr. Lin Cheng Ge during a meeting regarding the probability of NRR staff lectures for the National Nuclear Safety Administration. Because of the potential sensitivity of such arrangements, I informed CP&L of the generally applicable U.S. regulations and suggested they coni ct IDE for guidance. I have had no contacts with Sci-Tech, Inc. and have no knowledge of the firm's legal ownership or intentions regarding the simulator. As we discussed, CP&L intends to complete their transaction by May 10 unless they receive any communications to the contrary from us or other responsible agencies. 1 De Centre
