By letter dated November 19, 1990, as revised July 13, 1991 and October 2, 1991, Duke Power Company (OPC) requested relief from ASME Code Section XI inservice inspertion (ISI) and hydrostatic pressure test requirements for McGuire Nuclear Station Unit 1. Specifically, GPC requested relief from the provisions of subparagraph IWA-2000(c) to add four weeks to the tem-year ISI interval (plus the twelve month extension allowed by INA-2400 (c)) to ensure that McGuire Unit 1 can operate until the end-of-cycle 8 refueling outsje currently scheduled to begin December 11, 1992.

The NRC stoff has reviewed and evaluated Relief Request 90-02.
