Subject: NRC Region I Inspections

The purpose of this letter is to solicit more detailed schedular information that will assist us in further developing our inspection program. Based upon your estimated mid-September 1984 facility readiness for fuel load, we intend to conduct inspections in a number of areas before this milestone in order to ascertain operational readiness. The specific areas are listed in the enclosure to this letter.

We request that a schedule be provided that indicates when each area will be complete and ready to undergo a detailed NRC inspection. The schedule should be sufficiently detailed to distinguish among the various subelements of the areas listed. Such information will assist us in effectively managing our efforts and resources. Based upon our prior experience with the fue: receipt, it is not advantageous from a resource expenditure standpoint to conduct multiple inspections in a given area. Accordingly, it would be appropriate to update your response, preferably on a monthly basis, to keep the projected schedule current.

As has been our policy and practices, NRC inspections, in general, will continue to be unannounced. The information in your response will be one of the factors considered by us in scheduling the nature and number of inspections. These inspections will form the basis for Region I in making a determination as to the state of operational readiness of the facility for fuel load.

A written response is requesed as soon as possible. Thank you for your cocperation in this matter.
