SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF SUPPLEMENT TO BOARD NOTIFICATION 92-01 IN THE MATTER OF NEW YORK POWER AUTHORITY (JAMES A. FITZPATRICK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT) AND MR. DAVID M. MANNING, SENIOR REACTOR OPERATOR AT FITZPATRICK

In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Commission and the Licensing Boards of new, relevant, and material information, this memorandum calls attention to the information presented below.

On January 27, 1992, the NRC staff issued Board Notification 92-01 which informed the Commissioners, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, and All Parties to the David M. Maining and New York Power Authority (NYPA) proceedings of recent circumitances that resulted in NYPA's termination of Mr. Manning's employment.

By letter dried January 24, 19°2, N'PA formally notified the NRC of this termination of employment in accordince with 10 CFR 50.74, "Notification of Change in Operator or Senior Operator Status." Enclosure 1 is a copy of this January 24, 1992, letter. Enclosure 2 is a copy of a letter from the NRC to Mr. David M. Manning, dated January 30, 1992, which acknowledges receipt of the aforementioned NYPA letter and informs Mr. Manning that, in accordance with 10 CFR 55.55(a), his license (SOP-10561-1) has expired.

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This supplement to Board Notification 92-01 is being brought to the attention of the Commission and the Licensing Board as information which may be relevant and material to issues which may be pending before the Commission and the Licensing Board.
