This letter is to inform you of activities that may occur as a result of a potential violation of your U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission license issued under Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 55 (10 CFR 55).

On December 26, 1991, the NRC received a report from the Iowa Electric Light and Power Company of two positive tests (one initial screening test and one confirmation test) for cocaine from a sample provided by you on December 16, 1991. The NRC intends to gather more information regarding this occurrence fo, possible enforcement action as provided by 10 CFR, Part 2, Appendix C, Section V.E., Enforcement Actions Involving Individuals. The enclosed letter to Iowa Electric Light and Power Company requests this information.

Compliance with the Fitness-For-Duty guidelines of 10 CFR, Part 26, Appendix A, is a condition of your individual operator's license. You were provided. via Generic Letter 91-16, dated October 3, 1991, with a copy of the applicable amendments to 10 CFR, Parts 2 and 55, that were in effect on the date the positive test results were reported. The descriptions therein will provide you with information regarding potential NRC actions in this matter. You will be advised, by separate correspondence, regarding any action the NRC deems necer lary.
