SUMMARY OF MEETING CONCERNING TO ELECTRIC LICENSING ACTIONS AND SUBJECT: COMMITMENTS

A meeting was held on January 9, 1992, to discuss licensing actions and commitments for CPSES. The NRC staff identified to TU Electric the need for license amendments to provide a detailed discussion of the effect of proposed changes on plant safety so as to facilitate NRC staff review of the amendment requests. TU Electric was requested to provide license amendment requests 18 months in advance of the need date; except for changes that provide a safety benefit, which can be reviewed in a shorter time frame commensurate with the safety significance of the proposed amendment.

For changes to commitments established for TU Electric, different approaches were discussed dependent upon the status of the specific unit (operating or under construction). For an operating plant such as Unit 1, the use of 10 CFR 50.59 is appropriate to determine whether prior NRC approval is required to make a change in a commitment. For Unit 2, the staff noted that the method for highlighting changes to the FSAR is very good. For other commitments, the staff expects a similar level of notification of any changes made to other programs provided on the Comanche Peak docket that were evaluated and reported on in our Safety Evaluation Report and its supplements issued as part of the Unit 1 licensing process.
