PANEL SUBJECTS

- NRC Restart Coverage

The panel discussed the proposed termination of 24-hour inspection coverage of Unit 1 startup and power ascension. Barring any new problems, coverage will be terminated after stabilization at 100 percent power on April 10, 1994.

- Panel Assessment of Licensee Performance

Bill Johnson reviewed the draft assessment of licensee performance up to the 90 percent plateau. Panel members made comments and provided changes to the performance assessment comments to be presented during the public meeting scheduled for 9 a.m. on April 8, 1994.

- Public Meetings

The April 8 public meeting to discuss Unit 1 performance and Unit 2 status will be the last public meeting scheduled to focus on Unit 1. Future public meetings will focus on Unit 2 resolution of issues and readiness for restart. One or, possibly, two such meetings will be held before lifting the CAL for Unit 2.

- Next Panel Meeting

The next Panel meeting was scheduled for April 12. The meeting will focus on the necessary inspections to support issue resolution for Unit 2.

- Status of Panel Action Items

- Items from past meetings:

- (Closed) DRP has prepared four inspection reports to assign tracking numbers to DET items which are not considered to be restart issues. Reports 9348 through 9351 have been issued.
- Perform an internal audit of the RIV STP Restart File - Panel
- (Closed) D. Loveless will monitor licensee completion of internal commitments for standby diesel generators.
- (Closed) DRP will revise the augmented restart coverage plan to include discussion of an NRC staff assessment of licensee performance at about the 50 percent and 100 percent plateaus.

- New Items:

- Bill Johnson will prepare a restart action plan for Unit 2 to present to the panel for discussion.
- Bill Johnson will include the Panel Assessment of Licensee Performance in the next resident inspection report.
