This retter acknowledges the granting of a temporary waiver of compliance (TWOC) to the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) from the provisions of Technical Specification 2.6(1)a. "Containment System," to allow entry into the personnel air lock (PAL) while the inner door is inoperable. Such entry is a breach of containment integrity. Your letter (LIC-92-019R) to this office, dated January 29, 1992, provides the written basis for the TWOC.

The request for a TWOC was initially granted by me verbally on January 30, 1992, at 8:54 am, with the concurrence of NRC's Region IV office. The waiver will allow FCS to enter the PAL, for a period not to exceed 24 hours, with the plant operating, to repair the inner PAL door seals. This verbal request and the subsequent granting of the waiver were required to enable Fort Calhoun to enter containment in preparation for plant shutdown.

NRR performed an evaluation based on the information provided verbally and on the subsequent written request and supporting documentation and found your request for a TWOC acceptable. Ye r letter indicated that the outer PAL door would be open for short pariods and that during the time that it is open there will be no significant hazard o. . Arsible environmental consequences. This TWOC shall be valid through OBOJ hours on February 1, 1982.
