Proposed changes to TS 1.7, 4.6.1.1, 3.6.1.2, 3.6.3, 4.6.3.1, 4.6.3.2, 4.6.3.3, and TS Bases 3/4.6.4 were also associated with relocation of the above Tables to the FSAR.

Generic Letter (GL) 91-08. "Removal of Component Lists from Technical Specifications." was issued on May 6, 1991, to provide guidance for the removal of such component lists from the TS. My letter to you of May 10, 1991, indicated that your application for this amandment would be reviewed against the guidance provided in the generic letter. Subsequently, by letter dated January 16, 1991, you indicated that additional time was needed to review the impact of GL 91-08 on the amendment request and withdrew the request to be resubmitted at a later date.
