SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 91-11, "RESOLUTION OF GENERIC ISSUE 48, 'LCO'S FOR CLASS 1E VITAL INSTRUMENT BUSES,' AND 49, 'INTERLOCKS AND LCO'S FOR CLASS 1E TIE BREAKERS,' PURSUANT TO 10 CFR 50.54(f)" FOR CALVERT CLIFFS NUCLEAR POWER PLANT, UNIT NO. 1 (TAC NO. M82392) AND UNIT NO. 2 (TAC NO. M82393)

On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11 which contained the staff's resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required that licensees certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters or other onsite power sources for VIB, and tie breakers. If procedures do not exist, a justification demonstrating the reasons why the controls are not needed is required.

By letter dated January 31, 1992, you responded to the GL. You indicated that procedures for time limitations and surveillance requirements are in place at your site.

The staff has reviewed your response and finds that it meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11. This completes the staff's activities relating to the subject TAC Nos.
