Subject: USE OF MARIJUANA BY TWO GUARDS

The security force contractor's drug and alcohol screening program identified one security guard employed at Beaver Valley as a user of marijuana. The guard was dismissed on May 14, 1984. Another guard voluntarily admitted to having used marijuana, without taking the test. This guard was suspended on May 23, 1984, and entered a county drug rehabilitation program. His job status will be re-evaluated after completion of the rehabilitation program. There was no evidence that the drugs were used on site.

The NRC Resident Inspector learned of the incident from a local news reporter on June 13 and notified Region I at 8:30 a.m., June 14, 1984. The IAT has been notified. The licensee does not intend to notify the FBI, state, or local law enforcement authorities. The State of Pennsylvania has been informed.
