Dear Mr. Shelton:

This is to acknowledge receipt of Revision 4 to the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station Emergency Plan via letter dated December 12, 1991. We have reviewed Revision 4 and have determined that it is acceptable and does not decrease the effectiveness of your emergency planning for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station.

Revision 4 contains the updated evacuation study for the emergency planning zone (EPZ). The study essentially incorporated the data from the 1990 United States Census. Also noted was a change in the agency responsible for notification of boaters on Lake Erie during an emergency. The previous study identified the U.S. Coast Guard. The current study identified the Ohio National Guard as the responsible agency.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
