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1 that log, which is headed March 22, 1990, and proceed down
2 to the entry at 1243. It reads, and I quote, "DG1B tripped
3 on DG high lube oil temperature."

4 And I'll just ask you, when you went to obtain the
5 diesel generator information for Mr. Bockhold, did you count
6 that diesel test or that diesel run?

7 A While I don't remember the specifics of doing
8 this, I would have counted that by my criteria.

9 Q You would have counted that?

10 A Yes, sir.

11 Q Why would you have counted that -- is that -- why
12 would you have counted that?

13 A. A diesel generator high lube oil temperature
14 trip is a nonessential trip. It is a trip that is bypassed
15 during an emergency, therefore would not have prevented this
16 diesel from performing its function during an emergency.

17 Q Okay.

18 A There's nothing to indicate that's a problem.

19 Q And you're telling us here under oath today that
20 you would have counted that back on --
21 what day -- do you remember what day -- was this on a
22 weekend just prior to the presentation, or when did you get
23 this data?

24 A It was just shortly before the presentation. I do
25 not remember the exact date. It could have been either a

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1 Friday, Saturday, or Sunday. I do recall the place was sort
2 of vacant, but during outages we had scheduled heavy work
3 days Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and light
4 staffing Friday, Saturday, Sunday. So I can't really say
5 the exact date.

6 Q Did you get the feeling from Mr. Bockhold from
7 discussing with Mr. Bockhold that this was kind of an
8 eleventh-hour request by the NRC for data for this meeting
9 or did you feel that this was -- do you know what I mean by
10 eleventh-hour?

11 A Yes; I know what you mean. There was a deadline.
12 There was a Monday meeting, and this was being prepared
13 towards the end. Of course, with this process it took a
14 while to come to all of the conclusions so it would be
15 ~~necessity~~ be a -- somewhat of a last-minute evolution in
16 preparing the report --preparing the presentation.

17 I did not -- I don't recall it being an all of a
18 sudden on Friday the NRC says we want this on Monday. I
19 don't recall it being that type of presentation, but --

20 Q Well, I didn't mean that the entire presentation
21 was eleventh-hour, but this particular portion of the -- had
22 you worked on any portion of the presentation prior to
23 getting this data?

24 A Not that I recall.
