This is a partial response to your letter dated April 13, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of documents which pertain to three categories of information regarding Wolf Creek Nuclear Power Plant.

The two documents listed on the Appendix are already available in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC 20555. You may request copies of these documents by referring to the accession numbers. There is no charge for inspecting records maintained at the PDR. The charge for copying records maintained at the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 (CR 9.14(a). If you do not wish to visit the PDR to inspect or copy these records, you may obtain a copy by calling (202-634-3273) or writing directly to the PDR. Upon your agreement to pay the copying charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be copied by a private contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by the private contractor for copying charges, plus tax and postage.

The search for and review of additional documents subject to your request have not been completed. As soon as the search and review are completed, we will advise you of our disclosure determination.
