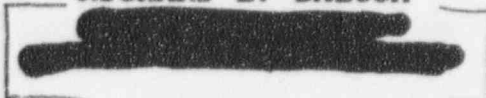

Dear Mr. Lieberman:

Enclosed is my response to the Demand for Information (DFI) sent to me by the NRC on September 29, 1993. I have submitted two versions of the DFI response. One contains the names of personnel and associated information about them, and its disclosure could represent an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The other has been redacted to exclude the names of individual personnel. I request that the non-redacted version be exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790 and 9.17.

As noted in my response to the DFI, I believe that there is no sound basis whatsoever for any enforcement action against me or anyone else who participated in the matters described in the DFI. I would welcome the opportunity to discuss the facts associated with these matters.
