SUBJECT: CLOSEOUT OF NRC GENERIC LETTER NO. 88-11, NRC POSITION ON  
RADIATION EMBRITTLEMENT OF REACTOR VESSEL MATERIALS AND ITS  
IMPACT ON PLANT OPERATIONS, SEABROOK STATION, UNIT 1, MPA A023  
(TAC NO. M75781)

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we have reviewed your  
response to NRC Generic Letter 88-11 and now consider the issue closed.

By your letter number NYN-88155, dated November 30, 1988, New Hampshire Yankee  
responded to NRC Generic Letter 88-11 for the Seabrook Station, Unit 1. In  
NYN-88155, you indicated that the current plant pressure-temperature heatup and  
cooldown curves are based upon NRC Regulatory Guide 1.99, Revision 1, and are  
correct until the second plant refueling outage. You further indicated that a  
change to Technical Specifications will be submitted for approval and new plant  
pressure-temperature heatup and cooldown curves will be developed based upon  
NRC Regulatory Guide 1.99, Revision 2, prior to the second plant refueling  
outage presently scheduled to begin in September, 1992.

Based on our review of your response, we conclude that the actions taken to  
date, fully respond to the issues identified in the subject generic letter.  
Therefore, we consider this issue and TAC No. M75781 closed by this letter.  
The staff may conduct an inspection of your implementation at a later time.
