SUBJECT: REQUESTED MODIFICATION OF HYDROGEN PURGE VALVES - MILLSTONE UNIT 2

We have reviewed your May 15, 1984 response to our April 25, 1984 letter "Completion of Issues Concerning Containment Venting and Purging at Power." Since you plan to appeal the staff position on Item II.E.4.2.7 of NUREG-0737 requiring the hydrogen purge valves to close on a high radiation signal, we request that detailed analyses supporting your position be provided prior to the appeals meeting. We understand as per telecon with M. Cass of your staff, that it is your intention to provide this detailed analysis by June 30, 1984. We will provide you with the staff's analysis shortly thereafter, and prior to the actual meeting itself. Please let us know if your schedule for this item changes.

The information requested in this letter affects fewer than 10 respondents; therefore OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 96-511.
