This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. B. Earnest and T. Dexter of this office on January 6-10, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Arkansas Nuclear One facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The inspection involved the review of certain areas of your physical security program.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. These included selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

During the exit meeting on January 10, 1992, you provided three commitments, which have been delineated in paragraphs 3.3, 3.4, and 3.8. Please advise us if our delineation of your commitments is different than what you intended.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report.
