Dear Mr. Mendonca:

The Decommissioning Plan for The Catholic University of America AGN-201 research and training reactor has been reviewed and approved by the University Radiation Safety Committee, It is submitted herewith for NRC approval.

Appendix G to the Plan is a revised edition of the Radiation Safety Manual which is pending review by the Radiation Safety Committee. Replacement pages for the 1992 edition will be forwarded when the Committee has completed its review. The revised (1992) edition is submitted with the Plan because, with such minor revisions as the Commit's may require, it will be the edition of the manual under which the Decommissioning Plan will be executed. The Commission possesses the previous edition of the manual.

The reactor fuel will be returned to DOE custody at the earliest opportunity. No other portion of the Decommissioning Plan will be executed until NRC approval to proceed is received.
